Position: Part Time P.A.T.H. Outreach Worker (20 hours per week)

Position Summary

Do you want to work for a person-centered results-oriented leader in crisis intervention, suicide prevention and community resources who provides opportunities for professional growth? Do you have a passion for helping people by providing support and connect them to the services they need? We are looking for a self-motivated compassionate individual to work a flexible part-time schedule. The successful candidate will work on the Path Outreach team. The candidate must demonstrate the ability to be a good communicator, empathetic, customer service oriented, collaborative, detailed oriented with good computer skills.

In 2021 Help Network will celebrate our 50th Anniversary that has grown into providing 24 hours a day 7 days a week Crisis Intervention/Suicide Prevention and Information Referral service that covers 5 counties in Northeast Ohio. Help Network also provides 15 other programs including Guardianship and Representative Payee services, Victims of Crime Assistance, Education and Prevention surrounding mental illness and addiction, along with housing to name a few. Help Network is certified by The Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, Accreditations with American Association of Suicidology (AAS), Association of Information and Referral Services (AIRS) and the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF).

Responsibilities:

The P.A.T.H. Outreach Worker conducts street outreach by visiting homeless shelters, works with the Rescue Mission, visits bus stations, soup kitchens, parks, and other areas the homeless congregate to help improve their quality of life. They will assist homeless individuals and establish a working relationship with individuals in need of mental health services, co-occurring disorder treatment, housing, benefits assistance and refers them to the appropriate organizations as needed. The outreach worker takes appropriate action to deal with any of the homeless emergency situations as directed by their supervisor. Must have access to reliable transportation and be available to work non-traditional hours.

Qualifications: High School Degree or G.E.D.
